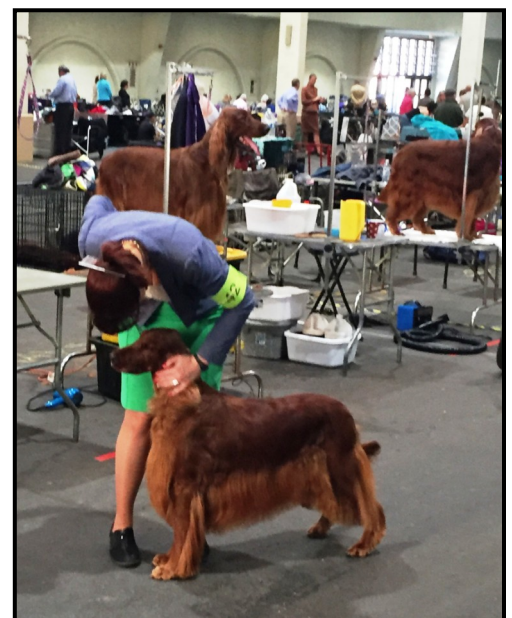
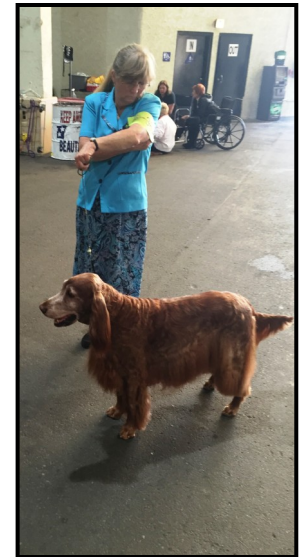
FROM THE PRESIDENT

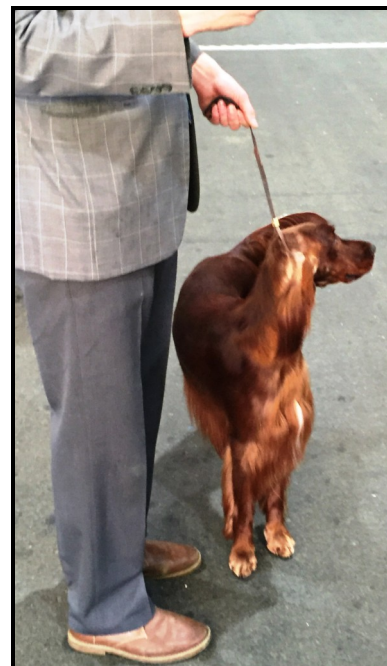

BOARD MEETING: Called to order at 7:02 but a motion was made by Valerie and seconded by Lynn to postpone business until the General Meeting. Board meeting adjourned at 7:03 pm.

GENERAL MEETING: Called to order at 7:04 pm. Members present: Kathy Whiteis, Lynn Aung-Levin, Chris Cohen-Richards, Jill Merrifield and Valerie Mahoney. Motion to approve the minutes from the Christmas Party Meeting on December 19, 2015 was made by Valerie and seconded by Lynn. Minutes were approved.

OFFICERS REPORTS:

- President - Chris Cohen-Richards – No report.
- Vice President – Rickard Borg – Absent. No report.
- Treasurer - Valerie Mahoney – Provided the Treasurer's report for December and the annual Treasurer's Report. Beginning balance on December 1st was \$4,431.78 and ending balance was \$4,709.31. Complete monthly and annual reports attached.
- Secretary - Jill Merrifield – No report.

COMMITTEE REPORTS:

- Newsletter (Chris Cohen-Richards) – went out on time, but the date for parade needs to be corrected in it.
- Facebook (Chris Cohen-Richards) – nothing to report. Valerie will get a photo for Chris.
- Membership (Lynne Aung-Levin) – nothing new to report. Members are mailing their dues now. Val will send another notice after the 15th of the month reminding members to pay their dues.
- Rescue (Vacant) – Sherry is filling in while the club looks for a replacement rescue point of contact and provided the following information to Chris to share. There were three requests for adoption of an Irish Setter: two men interested in puppies and a woman looking for a puppy or very young dog. The woman was sent an application with a self-addressed stamped envelope, but has not responded.
- Rec Center Meeting (Alexis Heath) – Absent. No report.

OLD BUSINESS:

- Ophthalmologist presentation – Chris did query other clubs about a lecture by this veterinarian, but there has been no interest to date. Jill suggested that this issue be discarded permanently since there is apparently no interest from any local dog clubs. If dog owners need to find out information regarding this topic, they will go directly to the ophthalmologist personally.
 - Rescue Chairperson - Right now rescue is done by committee, but the club is still looking for someone to take over as rescue chairperson. Sherry will still stay on as contact person until a new chairperson comes on board.

SNAKE AVERSION CLASSES

This is the time of year when rattlesnakes begin showing in a big way. Our warm winter actually has brought them out sooner. One report indicated that dogs are 20 times more likely than a human to be bitten by a rattler and they're 25 times more likely than a human to die from the bite.

“We hear stories all the time during our classes about dogs dying of rattlesnake bites,” said Fred Presson, who, along with his wife, Tracy, teach snake aversion training classes all over California, from San Diego to Chico, and at High On Kennels in Santa Ysabel. “We were in Calabasas over the weekend doing a clinic and heard a horror story about a dog getting bitten and dying from the bite.”

Some dogs are saved, but veterinarian bills can run from \$1,500 to over \$5,000, depending on the amount of time in the clinic. One way to save big money and educate your dog to the danger of snakes is to enroll him or her in a snake avoidance class, and the sooner, the better.

On weekends in March, April & May, the San Diego Chapter of the North American Versatile Hunting Dog Association is sponsoring rattlesnake avoidance classes at the Rancho Jamul Ecological Reserve. The cost is \$75. The Pressons from High On Kennels will teach the classes, according to Mark Miller of NAVHDA.

I've watched these classes taught at Presson's ranch, and they're done expertly and with care for the dogs and the snakes. The dogs are taught how to identify the sight, smell and sounds of snakes, and through repeat training, learn to stay away from them.

What always impressed me about the furry students in the class is that the pupils just weren't hunting dogs or big Labs and Irish Setters. There were Pomeranians, cocker spaniels, Chihuahuas and other small pets. Whether you hunt, hike or camp with your dog, snake aversion class is one you don't want to skip. And this one at the Jamul Ecological Reserve on Saturday allows you and your dog the opportunity to visit one of the finer, undeveloped areas of our back county.

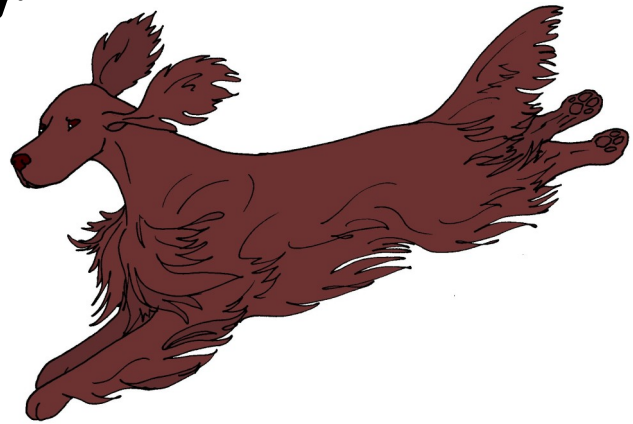
