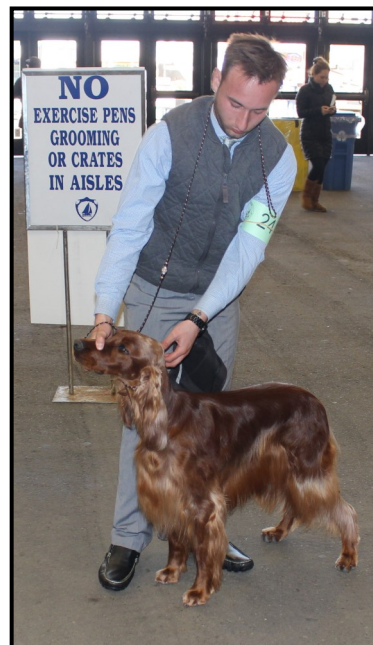

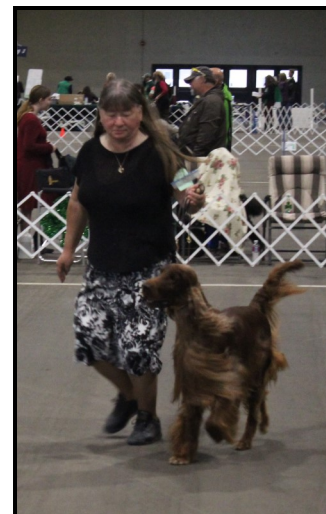

GENERAL MEETING: Called to order at 7:06 p.m. by Chris Cohen-Richards. Members present: Chris Cohen-Richards, Kathy Whiteis, Sherry Rez, Robert Rez, Valerie Mahoney, Alexis Heath, Linda Kenan, Rickard Borg, Alice Borg, Rebecca Seftl, Lynne Aung and Jill Merrifield. Linda Kenan made a motion, Jill Merrifield seconded the motion and the members voted to approve the prior minutes as written.

- Facebook (Chris Cohen-Richards) – There are 241 likes and 236 followers.
- Membership (Valerie Mahoney) – As required, Val had club members read in Spring and Christopher LaPlant for the second time. The club members unanimously voted in the LaPlants.
- Rescue (Rebecca Seftl) – Rebecca relayed the active and widespread process of finding a forever home for the older shelter setter. The dog was picked up by Terry Balsley (from Save Our Setters), who will foster her. Sherry helped “a lot” with the process and provided such wonderful assistance, thank you Sherry!! Rebecca has also digitized the adoption paperwork to make sending and receiving applications easier for the future. Nice job, Rebecca. We appreciate everything you do. The club discussed better ways update animal / rescue agencies about changes in the points of contact for our club. There is a disconnect. Rebecca said she will work on a document to address that. Rickard stated he believes we should meet with the local people from the Save Our Setters (their home base is in Tennessee). This will be discussed at a future time.
- Show (Linda Kenan) – Linda relayed the trophy donations this year have been wonderful. There is only one (maybe two) that have not been paid for with donations. That is amazing! Chris received an e-mail stating he was supposed to pick up judges from the airport at the time when our club is setting up in Del Mar. Discussions show that our club picks up the judges from their hotels and delivers them to the fair grounds on show day, but has not done airport pick up previously. Chris was going to contact Barbara about this. The club needs to be at Del Mar Thursday afternoon for set up. Linda suggested a theme for next year's show could be “Artists Around the World”. The club discussed this and liked the idea. More to follow.

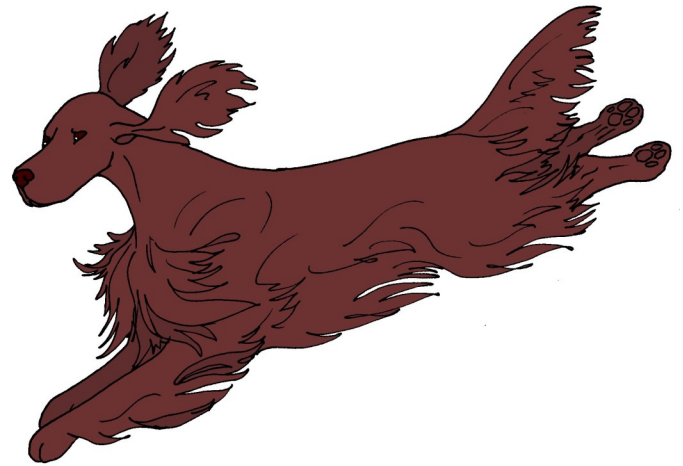

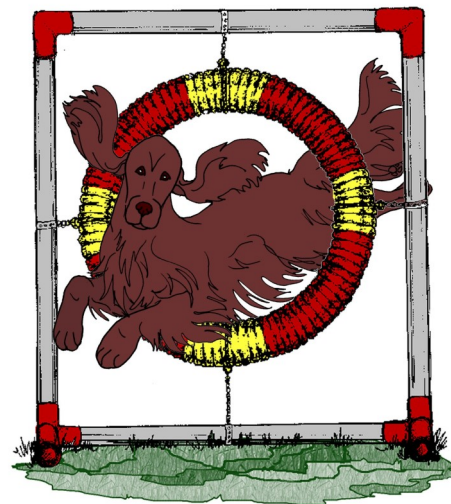
