

Rebecca has also digitized the adoption paperwork to make sending and receiving applications easier for the future. Nice job, Rebecca. We appreciate everything you do. The club discussed better ways update animal / rescue agencies about changes in the points of contact for our club. There is a disconnect. Rebecca said she will work on a document to address that. Rickard stated he believes we should meet with the local people from the Save Our Setters (their home base is in Tennessee). This will be discussed at a future time.

• Show (Linda Kenan) – Linda relayed the trophy donations this year have been wonderful. There is only one (maybe two) that have not been paid for with donations. That is amazing! Chris received an e-mail stating he was supposed to pick up judges from the airport at the time when our club is setting up in Del Mar. Discussions show that our club picks up the judges from their hotels and delivers them to the fair grounds on show day, but has not done airport pick up previously. 
